

Your Guide to



Registration

Our camps are designed for the developmental stage of each age group, therefore, grade levels must be observed. Campers may attend only those camps for which they are registered. Registration closes the Monday prior to the first day of camp. Please note that 4K-K campers must be four years old and fully potty-trained.

Cancellations & Refunds

McWane Science Center reserves the right to cancel camps that do not meet minimum enrollment. If a camp is cancelled by us, a full refund will be returned to the registrant. If a registrant cancels a camp, a 50% refund will be made if the registrant notifies the Camp program in writing, which is emailed to pchowning@mcwane.org, no later than 10 working days prior to the start camp. Otherwise, no refunds will be made.

Lunch & Snacks

Parents/Caregivers are responsible for lunch every day. Campers may bring a nut-free packed lunch, or you may purchase lunch through the Bean Sprouts Café (info available on page 16). This will be an added cost and the option is available with your camp purchase. For the health and safety of all our campers, peanut butter and nuts are prohibited in packed lunches. Sunflower butter is a good alternative and can be found in most grocery stores.

REMEMBER TO INDICATE ALL ALLERGIES AT REGISTRATION.

Snacks are provided in all camps. Campers are welcome to bring water bottles if they would like to, although water is provided in the classrooms. Water bottles must be labeled and secured in a lunch bag or backpack.



Drop-off & Pick-up

You must come in with your camper to sign them in before camp and sign them out after camp. Feel free to use our parking deck located on 2nd Avenue North. Parking tokens will be provided for you to exit the deck, free of charge. The loading zone on 2nd Avenue North is also available for quick drop off and pick up, however McWane Science Center cannot guarantee that you won't be ticketed. The person signing in your child at the beginning of camp each day will be given a **CAMPER CHECK OUT CARD**. The person who picks up your camper **MUST** present that card. If they do not have the card, we will check to see if their name is on the approved sign out list and will check their ID. If we do not have a person's name on the approved sign out list, we will not release your child to them, and we will call the number on the daily sign in sheet for clarification.

Before and after care of campers is available as an additional add-on. This price varies on the camp season.

Before & After Care

Before Care is available for all campers from 7:45-9:00 AM for an additional fee. After Care is available for 1st-7th grade campers from 4:00-5:30 PM, also for an additional fee. Structured activities and games will be provided during both care periods.

Schedule

- **4K - Kindergarten Camps**

Half-Day camps start at 9:00 a.m. and end at 12:30 p.m.

Campers may be dropped off no earlier than 9:00 AM, or 7:45 AM with the Before Care add-on, and must be picked up by 1:00 PM.

- **1st - 7th Grade Camps**

Full-day camps begin at 9:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m.

Campers may be dropped off no earlier than 9:00 AM, or 7:45 AM with the Before Care add-on, and must be picked up at 4:00 PM, or no later than 5:30 PM with the After Care add-on.

Late Arrival & Early Pick-up

If you arrive after check-in, or need to pick your camper up early, please proceed to the security desk or ticket counter, and they will call a camp representative. Please remain in the lobby until your camper is signed in or out. *Note: there will be no early pick-up/drop-off between 11:45 to 12:00 and 3:45 to 4:00. These are transition times for campers and staff, so please plan accordingly.

Late Arrival

A camp representative will meet you in the lobby to sign your camper in. They will provide you with a camp check-out card and parking token, if needed.

Early Pick-Up

Provide the camper's name and age group/camp name to security or ticketing staff. A camp representative will escort your child to the lobby. You will need to present the camp check-out card or a valid ID to sign out your camper. Please remain in the lobby until they are brought to you. To ensure the safety of all campers, your child will not be dismissed until a camp representative has brought them to you and you have signed them out. Please **DO NOT** leave with your child if you have not spoken to a camp representative **AND** signed them out. Campers may not meet parents/caregivers outside of the designated pick-up area.

Camp Inclusion

We work to ensure that everyone, regardless of learning ability, cultural background, faith, income, or race, can reach their fullest potential with dignity. Campers, volunteers, and staff can look forward to interacting and learning within a welcoming environment.



Late Fees

4K-Kindergarten campers must be picked up by 1:00 PM. All other campers must be picked up by 4:00 PM, or by 5:30 PM if enrolled in the optional After Care add-on. A \$5 late pick-up fee will be charged for every 10 minutes a camper remains after the scheduled pick-up time.

Camp Behavior Policy

To successfully attend all McWane Camps, children must be able to independently function in a group setting without consistent one on one support. They must be able to follow verbal instructions and rules and resolve conflicts without physical contact or verbal abuse. Camp management will communicate behavior issues with the camper and with their caregiver when necessary. Repeated behavior issues may result in dismissal from the program.

Member Benefits

McWane Members receive special benefits when registering for camps, including early registration access and discounted pricing. Early registration gives Members priority access to camp spots before they open to the general public.

For Summer Camps, Members receive 15% off tuition during the early registration period. After early registration ends, the Member discount for Summer Camps is 10%.

For Spring Break and Winter Camps, Members receive \$10 off on camp tuition throughout the entire registration period.

Discounts and early registration benefits are available to active Members at the time of registration and cannot be applied retroactively. Camp availability is limited, and early registration is encouraged.
